

Numbers in Act One of *L'elisir d'amore*

THE VILLAGERS

CHORUS. Establishes the rural village.

ARIA. Nemorino sighs over the unattainable Adina.

ARIA/CHORUS. Adina reads story of Tristan and Isolde.

THE OUTSIDERS

ARIA. Belcore arrives and flirts with Adina (*only first part played*)

DUET. Adina tells Nemorino she cannot love him (*only recit played*).

CHORUS/ARIA. Dr. Dulcamara arrives and touts his quack remedies (*not played*)

DUET. Nemorino asks for "Isolde's potion"; Dulcamara sells him wine, with the warning that it will take a day to work (*only sample played*)

FINALE SEQUENCE (featured)

SOLO. Nemorino decides to take the Elixir there and then, and immediately starts feeling the results.

DUET. Adina enters, surprised to see Nemorino so cheerful, but he tells her to wait just one day.

TRIO. Belcore enters. Both he and Adina are infuriated by Nemorino's indifference, and she agrees to marry the sergeant just to spite him.

ENSEMBLE. The soldiers come in with the message that the troop has been ordered to leave. Adina agrees to get married at once. This devastates Nemorino, because the Elixir will not have worked by then.
